

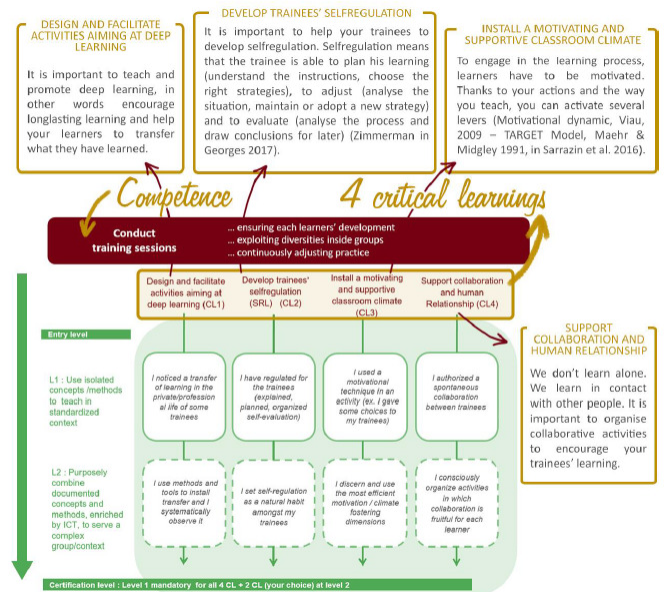
THE 4TH CERTIC TRANSNATIONAL MEETING HELD IN APRIL 2017

In the period of 27 - 28 of April 2017, the CERTIC partnership held its fourth working meeting in Porto. In the two days meeting the main focus had been put on revising and finalizing the Certic Competence Grid and Certic Training program in order to facilitate the recognition and a transparent validation of training outcomes and their transferability between operators and between countries (professional and geographical mobility).



CERTIC COMPETENCE GRID

In the period of Nov 2016 - Feb 2017 based on the transnational benchmark report on the use of ICT in training programmes for trainers in adult education and based on the methodological framework proposed by LabSET from Belgium the CERTIC partnership worked on describing the certification process of the training on how to use ICT tools in trainings in the third sector. As a result, the CERTIC Competence Grid was developed, including elements such as competences, methodological ideas, resources or trainings. Based on the CERTIC Competence Grid a Training program CERTIC has been elaborated.



This training booklet is made up of three parts : the first part gives general information about the programme (activities to be organized, competences to develop, final evaluation); in the second part, the participant can choose the training activities he/she wants to attend; in the third part, the participant can show evidence of his/her development such as: training activities attended; development of competences in: 1) designing and facilitating activities aimed at deep learning) (CL1); 2) developing trainees selfregulation (CL2); 3) installing a motivating and supportive classroom climate (CL3); 4) supporting collaboration and human relationship (CL4).

CERTIC could thus be a training with a transnational dimension which offers interested trainers the opportunity to complement a national certificate with training activities offered by CERTIC.

NEXT STEPS

In the next project phase the partnership will pilot and evaluate the single modules of the CERTIC training program and develop the sustainability strategy of the CERTIC project.
